[29 January 2018] – The All-American Selection Committee today released the list of current class of 2019 graduates set to play in the All-American Bowl Presented By American Family Insurance on Saturday, January 5, 2019. The Bowl will be nationally televised, live on NBC at 1:00 PM Eastern, from the Alamodome in San Antonio, Texas.
